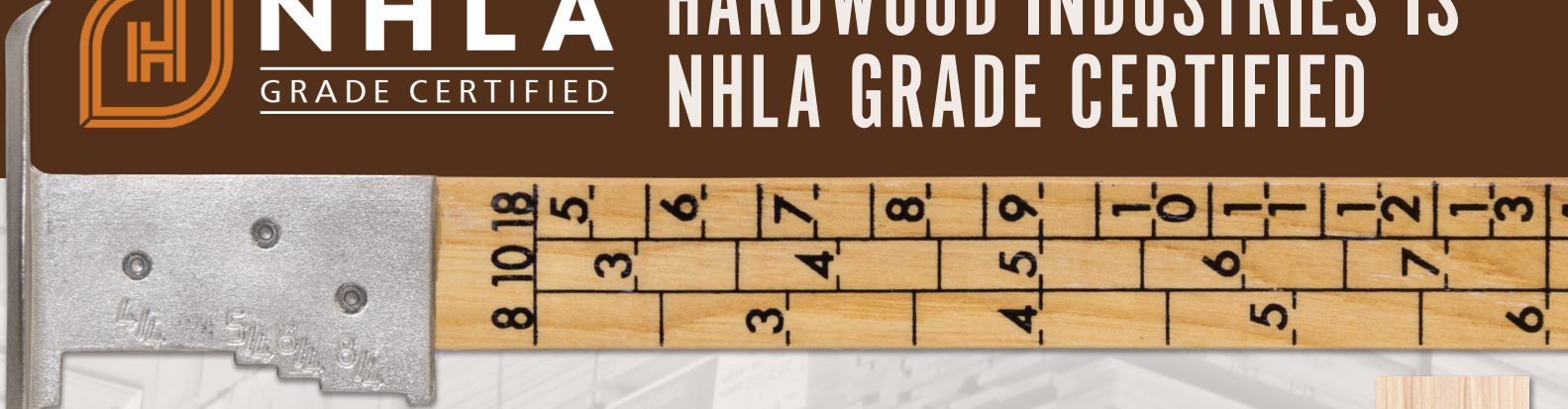

"The NHHLA Facility Grade Certification Program is a quality assurance program for NHHLA members only, designed to help differentiate your business from the competition and assure customers that your lumber is "On Grade." Companies that participate in this program are illustrating to customers and potential customers, their willingness to openly submit to independent quality checks and stand behind the quality of their lumber." - NHHLA

In 2017, Hardwood Industries submitted an application to be NHHLA "Grade Certified." After inspections of randomly selected lumber by a trained NHHLA certification inspector:

NHHLA Minimum Standard

Combined money value (grade and/or tally) must fall within 4% of invoice amount.
